**PARENT/CARER**

- Ensure a regular and punctual attendance avoiding holidays in school term time
- Provide the correct school uniform and school equipment required
- Support the completion of home study by taking an interest and providing a quiet, suitable environment
- Help to support the school's work by reading and signing the Home School Agreement and by attending Consultation Evenings and other school events
- Support the school's Behaviour for Learning and Discipline Policy respecting the professionalism of the staff in their use of rewards and sanctions
- Communicate with school on a regular basis sharing information that may affect progress and behaviour
- Help to develop the student's sense of personal responsibility showing care and respect for others by observing the Behaviour for Learning policy and Respect for All statement
- Support the values of the school and involvement in attendance at Cathedral, recognising that you have accepted a place for your child to attend a Church of England School.
