Course	Subject specific requirements
A Level Art & Design	
A Level Biology	Grade 6,6 for GCSE combined science or grade 6 in Biology studied in Triple science Must have an average points score at GCSE of 6 of above
A Level Business Studies	Grade 5 for GCSE Maths and grade 4 for English
A Level Chemistry	Grade 6,6 for GCSE combined science or grade 6 in Chemistry studied in Triple science. Grade 6 is required in GCSE Maths Must have an average points score at GCSE of 5 of above
A Level DT Product Design	Grade 4 in Combined Science and grade 5 in Maths
A Level Drama & Theatre Studies	Grade 4 in Drama GCSE or if not studied a grade 4 in English Literature and/or equivalent proof of performance work e.g. LAMDA Grade 5 and above
A Level Economics	Grade 5 in Maths and English
A Level English Literature	Grade 5 in GCSE English Literature and English Language
A Level Geography	Grade 5 in GCSE Geography
A Level History	Grade 5 in GCSE History, or if not studied at GCSE in a related subject. Students will need an interest in History.
A Level Mathematics	Strong grade 6 in GCSE Mathematics (within 5 marks of a grade 7) Must have an average points score at GCSE of 5 of above
A level Further Mathematics	Six GCSE grades at 5-9 including English Language Grade 7 in GCSE Mathematics
A Level Media Studies	Grade 4 in GCSE English. An interest in Media and the technologies that create the products
A Level PE	Grade 5 for GCSE PE and Combined Science & Maths. Already a member of a sports club outside of school and playing in competitive matches/ competitions.
A Level Physics	Grade 6,6 for GCSE combined science or grade 6 in Physics studied in Triple science. Grade 6 is required in GCSE Maths Must have an average points score at GCSE of 5 of above
A Level Psychology	Grade 5 in GCSE Maths & English
A Level RE	Grade 5 in GCSE RE
A Level Sociology	Grade 4 in GCSE English Language
Diploma/ Extended Diploma in Health & Social Care	Grade 4 in GCSE English A keen interest in working in the health and social care sector Must be involved in work experience within the health and social care sector throughout the course.

You must have an APS of 5.0 or above to study A Levels and an APS of 4.0 to study Health and Social Care.
